

A transnational non-formal education youth worker training programme targeting youth and youth workers, aiming to promote active citizenship, young people's sense of initiative and youth entrepreneurship including social entrepreneurship.



About the project

entreYOUTH is a project of 2 years of duration. The partnership for this project is formed by six organizations from four European countries - The University of Almeria (Spain), YET (Greece), HELIXCONNECT EUROPE (Romania), SCA (Spain), Ítaca (Spain), and C.I.P. Citizens In Power (Cyprus).

The motivation for this project stems from the need to address and respond to the apparent gap that exists in the provision of trainings and availability of trained youth workers with regard to equipping youth with enterprising skills in marginalized 'alternative food networks' (informal networks of food provisioning and redistribution especially among local & vulnerable groups).



Project results

During these 2 years, the project will develop 4 main outputs:


- Curriculum on sustainable & circular urban food enterprising (SURFE)
- · Youth worker train the trainer toolkit
- Community training event concept development (pilot)
- · A community food sharing cloud platform

The ultimate goal of this project is to equip youth with the know-how and experience to provide added value in alternative food networks by embedding sustainability and circular economy practices, especially those coming from vulnerable groups who do not possess entrepreneurial skills that would enable them to scale-up their ideas or to engage in social enterprising that would open up their opportunities beyond such alternative food.

In addition, entreYOUTH will facilitate digital certification according to Youthpass for youth participants and EntreComp and DigComp for youth workers.

Project launch

The project was launched in February 2022, the month in which the partnership had its first meeting. During the meeting, the project coordinator shared with the partners the updated work plan and objectives to be achieved. Each partner has been assigned a role and some tasks and discussed further.
