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# Sustainable & circular urban food enterprising (SURFE) curriculum

This Result offers a non-formal curriculum that paves the way for formal validation and transferability, is under development by all partners and is now at the final stage of its completion. It is expected to be completed over the next few weeks and covers the following:

Finding opportunities from waste in the transition from a linear to a circular economy and food; Social entrepreneurship and entrepreneurship principles; Motivating, inspiring, and training the community to engage, and Shifting to digital.

A blend of innovative approaches is used to build the SURFE (Sustainable & circular urban food enterprising) curriculum, always with a learner-centered philosophy in mind. The techniques used are: Technology-Based Learning, Virtual Community Environment Simulator, Interactive training to enhance learners' engagement, Expositive videos to engage learners with the contents and Community Based Learning with on the-spot training, which is the most prominent practical methodological approach in this training course. Also, Case Studies will be incorporated using data collected.

This first youth-focused curriculum (with YOUTHPASS certificates) focuses on sustainable and circular urban food entrepreneurship with societal groups at risk as its key target groups. This helps to increase social value, lessen inequality, and foster civic involvement. It relies on a virtual community environment simulator as the primary non-formal evaluation method, enhancing skills and talents in a contextualized environment, and creates modular content that can be incorporated into any major e-learning platform.

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# Youth worker train-the-trainer toolkit

Regarding entreYOUTH's youth-worker train-the-trainer toolkit, the consortium has already started the development of the educational content which is expected to be completed by February. This deliverable represents the first attempt to offer a comprehensive blended training manual for junior and senior young workers (on sustainable and circular urban food entrepreneurship) while relying on online training methodologies.

It is important to highlight that the "young worker train the trainers toolbox" (TTT) is built in response to the skills gaps identified for youth workers. Thus, it aims to accomplish broader learning priorities like learner engagement, civic engagement, social cohesion, or employability, and is the very first TTT on circular and sustainable urban food enterprise that incorporates behavioral techniques and builds on the EntreComp and DigComp competency frameworks of the EU (and has EntreComp accreditation).

In conclusion, the final intellectual output of this impactful EU project will be concluded with the creation of a **digital open community food sharing cloud platform** that youth and society can utilise. The platform will address food providers and consumers who wish to announce food supply and food demand, allowing location tracking and needs filtering while offering direct messages and one2one connection.

We are more than excited to announce that the beta version of the platform will be ready in December 2022, marking the beginning of a long-term vision that aims to facilitate the collection of daily problems in terms of food security and show-case the problem of food waste availability in order to spur entrepreneurial ventures based on such informal alternative food networks.
